### 1. Minutes

The Minutes of the previous meeting, as circulated were agreed and duly signed by the Chairman. Proposed by SM, seconded by MA

### 2. Matters Arising

#### (a) Operation Watershed

ML and NC had met with Peter Smith and Gulu Sibanda from WSCC Highways to discuss our plans and works we had carried out already. Problem areas were pointed out to them - these had been highlighted by MTS when they had jetted and cleared the gullies: drain by Manor Cottages; drain by Manor Farm gateway; drain at top of Mill Close (sump at cricket field driveway and one by Opus); drain at Toots Corner and drain at Cora's Corner.

ML had met with Edburton Contractors to discuss these specific sites and also the footpath behind School Cottages and alongside Downmere. He is awaiting a quote from them. This will also include resetting the kerbs on Cora's Corner.

NC to contact MTS to book a CCTV survey of the specific areas highlighted by their survey.
