Mayfield Market Towns WILL AFFECT YOU, potentially devalue your home and devastate the wonderful countryside around you.

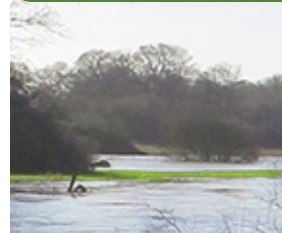
- This area is on a flood plain – a new town here is madness!
